**Response from Ealing Fields Residents Association to the PSPO Consultation**

Dear Sir/Madam,

Ealing Fields Residents' Association (EFRA) is a large residents' association with about 450 members in the Northfields/South Ealing area of the London Borough of Ealing representing some 2,000 households. It has been in existence since 1974. Our members live in properties in the area that stretches from Windermere Road in the north to Ealing Park Gardens/Lawrence Road in the south, and between Blondin Park/Northfield Avenue in the west and Weymouth Avenue in the east. EFRA is formally recognised by Ealing Council when we engage with the local authority on issues that affect our local community.

EFRA strongly supports the proposed renewal of the borough-wide **Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO)**.

We believe that maintaining safe, clean, and inclusive public spaces is vital for the wellbeing of all residents. Since its introduction, the PSPO has been a valuable tool in addressing persistent anti-social behaviour, including street drinking, fly-tipping, and intimidating conduct. The continuation of these powers will help ensure our parks, town centres, and residential areas remain welcoming and accessible for everyone.

We also welcome the Council's ongoing commitment to engaging the community in shaping local enforcement measures. Effective, proportionate use of PSPO powers — alongside continued investment in prevention and support services — is key to long-term community safety.

We encourage all residents to take part in the consultation and share their views to ensure that Ealing remains a safe and enjoyable place to live, work, and visit.
