Essential upgrade of your local electricity network

I am writing to inform you that Scottish and Southern Energy Power Distribution (SSEPD) will soon be starting works in your area to renew the existing 66,000 volt (66kV) underground electricity cables, ensuring the long-term security of your electricity supply.

This essential work will be carried out by us, J Murphy and Sons Ltd, as the main contractor.

The overall project which started in April 2014 is expected to last 18 months in total, with works carried out in various separate phases and locations around Ealing and Hounslow.

We have worked closely with Hounslow Council, Ealing Council, Transport for London, public transport services and the emergency service providers to plan the work and minimise disruption to road users.

Work is scheduled to start on Little Ealing Lane on Monday the 30th March 2015. These works will involve digging a series of trenches to install ducts for the electricity cables, which we will be installing later in the project.

To allow us to carry out our works whilst ensuring the safety of both the public and our workforce, traffic management measures will include the use of temporary traffic lights and local diversions, parking bay suspensions and footpath closures may also be required for these works. **Access to properties will be maintained throughout the duration of the works.**

We will do all we can to minimise any inconvenience while this work is being carried out but we do appreciate that some disruption may be caused. I'd like to apologise in advance and thank you for your patience as we go about our essential work.
